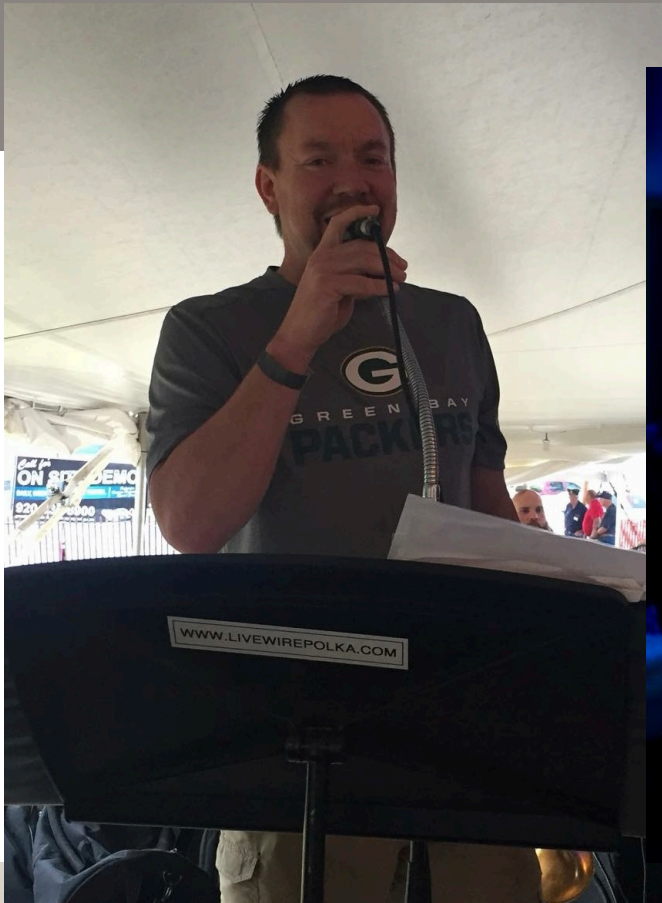


# Pat Maroszek
